

Guidelines for Pulling District-Owned Trailer with a Privately-Owned Vehicle

1. Any person requesting to pull either district-owned trailer must be at least 20 years of age. As the transportation department must process a driver record check, a copy of the driver's license of the person requesting to pull the trailer is needed. Up to three weeks are required for processing.
2. The requestor must show proof of current liability insurance.
3. Those with an unsatisfactory or questionable driving record or no proof of liability insurance will not be allowed to pull the trailer.
4. The vehicle used to pull the band trailer must be properly equipped, at no expense to the district, to pull the trailer. The vehicle must be at least a three-quarter ton pick-up with a receiver hitch and seven-pin plug for lights and electric trailer brakes.
5. The vehicle used to pull the FFA stock trailer must be properly equipped, at no expense to the district, to pull the trailer. The vehicle must be at least a half-ton pick-up with a two-inch ball and six-pin plug for lights and electric trailer brakes.
6. Changes are not to be made in the vehicle pulling the trailer or the driver who was approved without the consent of the transportation department. Individuals applying for the use of the trailer will sign a statement indicating he/she will be fully responsible for any damage to the trailer and/or for any and all resulting liability.
7. A \$25 trailer rental fee must be paid to the CTE office before use.
