**REQUIRED
SUPPLIES**

- Pencil, red pen, highlighter, and dry erase marker

EXPECTATIONS

- Come to class prepared and ready to work each day.

HOMEWORK

Homework is assigned most every night and must be completed the night it is assigned. Students must follow my homework policy when completing homework. An example has been provided for each student to follow. Homework will receive a failing grade if it is not done correctly. If answers are posted, then I expect students to re-do their work BEFORE it is submitted. Students are NOT allowed to re-do an assignment after it is turned in and graded, if answers were posted in advance. If any work is having trouble loading on Canvas, then you need to immediately send a message to the teacher.

ABSENCES

Absences should be kept to a minimum. Students are responsible for making sure that all missed work is completed. If you are absent, you are expected to get notes and assignments, which are available in your canvas account. If a student is absent the day before any Test, they **MUST** take the assessment on that day. **NO** new material will be covered the day before a Test. Refer to the student handbook for more policies concerning absences.
