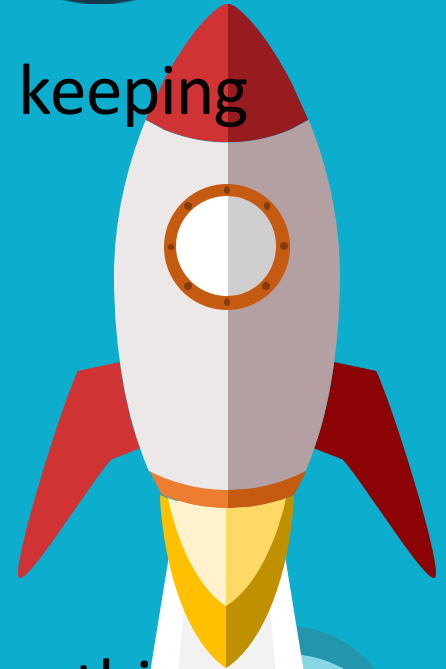

Math and Science Club

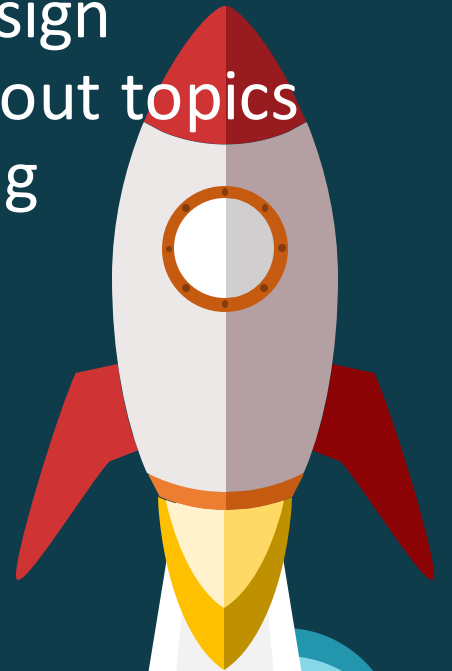
- Description: We will attend at least 3 Saturday competitions throughout the year, plus the state competition in April.

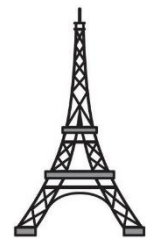
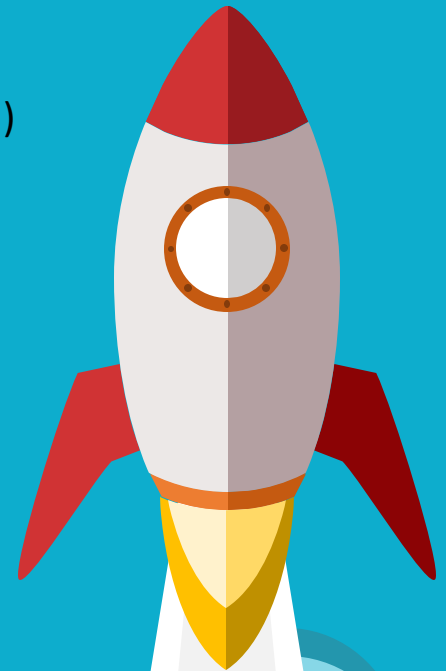


Teacher Helper Club

Art Club

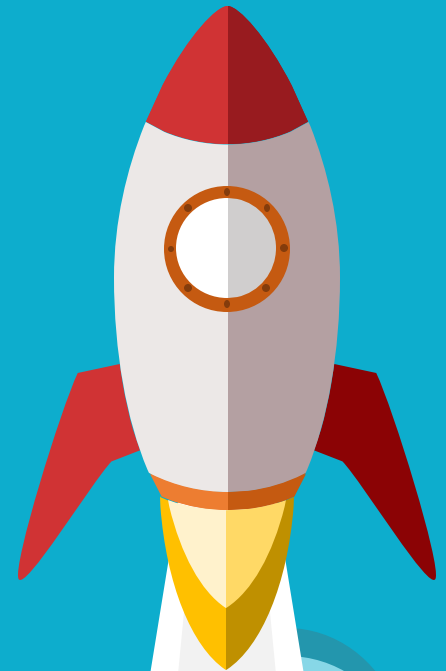
