Communication: Your child's conduct and work habits will be communicated via their MACK binder and/or parent phone call, as needed.

Conduct Report Card Grades

E—Excellent—The student has exceptional behavior, is consistently cooperative, shows respect for self and others and observes rules and regulations with no office referrals.

S—Satisfactory—The student has earned conduct marks resulting in parent contact with no office referrals, but usually displays good behavior, cooperates and is usually observant of school rules.

N—Needs Improvement—The student's behavior requires improvement and there have been violations of school rules resulting in consequences, such as parent contact via telephone or a possible office referral.

U—Unsatisfactory—The student's behavior is poor and uncooperative. The student frequently disrupts class and shows little respect for school rules, resulting in consequences, such as parent contact via telephone or an office referral.
