

# PBIS

(Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support)

Pearland ISD has adopted a system that acknowledges students for being safe, respectful, or responsible. School-wide expectations (SWE) will be taught consistently across the campus to ensure maximum instruction and to minimize challenging behaviors. SWE are social characteristics that we want students to display throughout their time in school and beyond. The expectations will be centered on three concepts:

1. Be Safe
2. Be Respectful
3. Be Responsible

Teachers and staff will be teaching and modeling SWE throughout the year. Our goal is to connect our language to these three concepts. When students leave our schools they will have many examples that will allow them to independently generalize these concepts to their relationships and community.

Students will be acknowledged for an appropriate display of SWE, for being safe, respectful, or responsible. Acknowledgements will occur in all areas of the campus (classroom, cafeteria, specials, hallway, etc.). Students will be recognized individually, as a class, and as a campus.

Visual cues will be posted in classrooms and in each common area.

When a correction is needed, teachers and staff will address it as a teachable moment. Staff will connect the challenging behavior back to the expectation that is violated to the expected appropriate behavior.

Your child's conduct & work habits grades will be communicated weekly. Parent contact will be made as needed throughout the year.
