ONLINE STUDENT REQUIREMENTS To Provide a Safe Learning Environment for All Learners

An “Acceptable Use” policy is a part of the online registration process for all Pearland ISD students agreeing to use district devices and Internet resources each educational year. The terms of the “Acceptable Use” policy continues to remain applicable; this “Online Etiquette” document is designed to provide a simple outline of

- Those who use district owned and maintained technologies to access the Internet at home are responsible for the set-up and cost of home internet service.

Students who are issued district owned and maintained tablets must also follow these guidelines:

- Keep the device secure and damage free.
- Use the provided protective case at all times.
- Devices should be charged each night.
- Do not loan out the device, charger or cords.
- Do not leave the device in your vehicle.
- Do not leave the device unattended.
- Do not eat or drink while using the device or have food or drinks in close proximity.
- Do not allow pets near the device.
- Do not place the device on the floor or on a sitting area such as a chair or couch.
- Do not leave the device near table or desk edges.
- Do not stack objects on top of the device.
- When carried outside, the device must be protected from the environment in such a way to prevent rain, snow, ice, excessive heat, and/or cold from causing damage.
- Do not use the device near water, household chemicals, or other liquids that could damage its electronic components.

REMINDERS REGARDING RESOURCES

When utilizing district technological resources, students are expected to adhere to the following:

- The district is not responsible for the content accessed by users who connect to the Internet via their personal mobile telephone technology (e.g., 3G, 4G service).
- Users must back up data and other important files regularly.

Virtual Class Daily Expectations

BEFORE CLASS



- Be dressed school appropriately and ready for class;
- Be in an appropriate workspace (not in bed);
- Have all needed school supplies near you;
- Assure you are in a quiet space;
- Assure the space is cleared of any non-class related items or people;
- Check your device to confirm everything works;
- Make sure your device is muted and the camera is turned on.

DURING CLASS

- Be on time for the synchronous sessions;
- Be actively engaged in lessons and participate appropriately;
- Keep your camera on unless otherwise directed by the teachers;
- Do not use any hand gestures or inappropriate images;
- Assure no friends or pets are visible in Teams;
- Do not eat while in class.



AFTER CLASS

- Follow the teacher's directions regarding assignments;
- Confirm all submissions are complete each day;
- Contact the teacher with class related questions or concerns.
