

Leader of the Pack Audition Schedule:

Day 1—Info meeting and clinic. Directors will go over audition expectations, answer any questions and teach the vocal audition pieces to all students who wish to audition. Students that miss the clinic will need to learn the pieces from a fellow auditionee.

- Copies of music will be available from Mr. Kessler.
- Copies of lead sides will be available on the Pearland Theatre Website.

Day 2 – Vocal auditions. Students will audition in groups assigned by the directors.

- If you need to leave early, you will need to speak with the Directors prior to the audition time so we can make appropriate changes. We cannot guarantee you will go early, but we will do everything we can to assist you.
- You will sing as a group once, and then will be asked to sing individually for this portion of the audition.

Day 3 – Lead auditions begin. This group will consist of students who are called back for specific roles. Sides and songs should be VERY FAMILIAR. Memorizing is encouraged, but not required.

Day 4 – Dance auditions. **STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BE DRESSED IN ALL BLACK DANCE WEAR – NO SHORT SHORTS, NO MIDRIFF BEARING TOPS.** Black leggings/basketball shorts and a black t shirt or tank top are fine. Students do not necessarily need dance shoes; however, they can be helpful. Students do not need character heels for the audition.

- Students will audition in groups of 5. The groups will be the same as the singing groups.
- You will be asked to change positions as many times as needed to fully assess the dance audition.

- All audition times are scheduled from 3- 5:30pm or 6pm. This is scheduled to give a bit of flexibility to directors. We may use the entire time, but if we are done early, we will dismiss early.
 - Side/acting auditions. Sides will be provided online. You may print it out for your use if you like.
 - Cast list will be posted on the Pearland Theatre Website Saturday 10/23. Students must understand that negative comments or social media posts regarding the cast WILL NOT be tolerated. We do NOT take casting lightly. Students that choose to react negatively on social media may forfeit their role in musical. Students may request a meeting with the Director within 3 days to go over the results of the audition. If students would like to meet, they must contact the director via email within 3 days.
 - Students cast in musical will be required to attend “Musical Registration” 10/26 @6:30pm with their parents.
