Come prepared. Bring the necessary supplies, including your FULLY charged device, pencils, folders, notebooks.

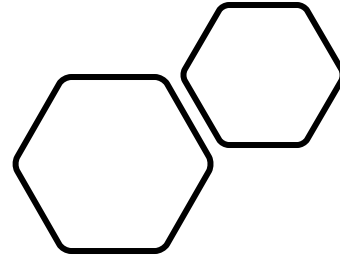


Be respectful to everyone, including yourself.

Grading Policy



Types of Grades:

- Daily Grades include classroom activities, homework, quizzes, in-class writing samples, or other in-class activities. Daily grades can be divided into different sub-categories, such as participatory daily grades (in-class activities, homework, etc.) and independent daily grades (quizzes, etc.).
- Major Grades include long-term projects, in-class assessments, and tests.

Classwork

Missing Work – It is the student's responsibility to ask the teacher for any missing work if they were absent or missed my class.

Corrections - Students may correct any failed assignments for up to a 70. All graded assignments are sent home thorough the red folders. The only exception is work done on Canvas.

Tests – Students may do corrections on tests. Students need to write **each question** they missed with the correct answer on a sheet of paper.
