TOMORROW - Wednesday, May 4, 2022, Pearland High School will administer the STAAR Biology and STAAR U.S History End-of-Course exam to all students enrolled in Biology or U.S. History and those who have not been successful on previous administrations of Biology or U.S. History.

- All students NOT taking the Biology or U.S. History STAAR assessment will arrive to campus at 11:45am for a modified bell schedule and should initially report to Bullard Cafeteria.
- All Biology and U.S. History students will report to their testing room at regular time, 7:15am. Room assignments will be posted in several locations and students will receive their test location the day before testing.
- Students who have a district device **will need to bring their district device on the day of the exam**. Devices will need to be fully charged and students need to bring their chargers.
- If you do not have a district device, a laptop will be provided to use during the exam.
- All students must bring their school ID.
- Once testing is complete, testing students will move to a modified bell schedule.
- **Bus Transportation will operate at the normal time**. Non-testing students who do not have transportation to arrive at 11:45am can ride the bus at the normal time. Non-testing students that arrive to campus will be housed in the Bullard Cafeteria until testing is complete.
- There will be no Turner travel in the morning, please report to campus of record. There will be travel for afternoon Turner classes.

Final Exams and exemptions are around the corner, all of the information you need has been posted on Pearland High Schools Home Page (and your parents also received an email through Skyward). Be sure to check out the web page and see the final exam schedule, see how many exemptions you can get per grade level, and make sure you know what the criteria is for each particular class. It is very important you check your skyward and pay for

any fees that are on your account. It takes 24 hours for fees to clear and you will not be able to exempt anything unless you have ALL fees paid.

All library materials checked out to students are due on Friday, May 6. Students must be clear of all library materials to be eligible for any final exam exemptions.

Both libraries will be **closed to both staff and students** for STAAR testing TODAY. Please DO NOT enter the libraries during testing, unless you are directly involved with the testing session. Students testing in the libraries may have extended time; do not assume that the libraries will be open in the afternoon after the regular testing session is completed.
