District Ratings and STAAR Testing Highlights

- **95%** overall STAAR participation rate; 6-7% above the state and region
- **15%** more students than the state and region passed all STAAR tests at all grade levels
- Met **100%** of the targets in Closing the Gaps
- Scored **15% higher** than the state and region in Reading in all grade levels (at Meets Grade Level or above)
- Scored **20% higher** than the state and region in Mathematics in all grade levels (at Meets Grade Level or above)
- All three high schools were **5-10% higher** than the state and region in Graduation Rate and College and Career Readiness

*The 2021 Accountability reflects the following adjustments: No A-F ratings or scale scores assigned; all districts and campuses received a label "Not Rated: Declared State of Disaster"; school progress/growth was not calculated; and no distinction designations were awarded.
