



CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) BUILDING ENTRANCE SELF-SCREENING

In the last 48 hours, have you experienced any of the following symptoms?

- Fever of 100.0 or above **OR** felt feverish; symptoms may include alternating shivering and sweating
- **New** muscle aches
- **New** cough
- Sore throat
- **New** trouble breathing, shortness of breath or wheezing
- Diarrhea
- **New** chills
- **New** loss of smell
- **New** loss of taste or change in taste

In the last 14 days, have you been in contact with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus, has COVID-19 or is under evaluation for coronavirus?

If you answered YES to any of the above, you MAY NOT enter the building today.

- **Employees should contact Human Resource Services or your supervisor.**
- **You should contact your primary care provider.** Your doctor will make the decision if you should get tested for COVID-19.
- **If you do not have health insurance,** you can still get tested for COVID-19 if your doctor or healthcare provider recommends it.
- **For information about testing,** call your doctor and/or access medical care the way you usually would.
- **You may also get tested for COVID-19 at public testing sites or drive-thru locations** in certain parts of Texas.
- **If you need help finding a doctor or accessing medical care,** call 2-1-1, and they will direct you to a low or no-cost provider in the area.
