- Providing staff to monitor your student during their learning.
- Daily dedicated remote learning support time as students complete their school assignments.
- Ensuring children are logged on and ready to participate in remote learning sessions with their teachers and classes.
- Assistance with homework assignments.
- Discussions with parents about student classwork, remote learning sessions and homework.
- Supporting healthy bodies through healthy lunch and snacks as well as outdoor sports and activities.
- Willingness to providing any additional training that you would recommend.
