**ORDER NO. 6 RE: ORDER PROHIBITING PLACEMENT OF
POLITICAL SIGNS ON COUNTY PROPERTY**

Motion by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Head that the following action be taken by the Court:

1. WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court determines and resolves that the placement on County property of political signs advertising candidates for political office is an inappropriate use of public property;
2. The Commissioners' Court hereby RESOLVES AND ORDERS that political signs advertising candidates for political office shall not be placed on County property and such placement of signs on county property is prohibited; with the exception that signs may be placed in an area outside of 100 feet or as set by law from voting locations located on County property during the period of time 12 hours before voting begins and 12 hours after the close of voting at that location.

Motion carried, all present voting aye.

**ORDER NO. 6 RE: AMENDMENTS TO ORDER PROHIBITING
PLACEMENT OF POLITICAL SIGNS ON
COUNTY PROPERTY**

Motion by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Stanley that the following action be taken by the Court:

1. The Court approves the following amendments to Court Order No. 6 of February 16, 2000 regarding placement of political signs on County Property to clarify that signs may be placed and remain at early voting locations from 12 hours before early voting through 12 hours after election day voting (amended and added language underlined):
2. The Commissioners' Court hereby RESOLVES AND ORDERS that political signs advertising candidates for political office shall not be placed on County property and such placement of signs on County property is prohibited; with the exception that signs may be placed in an area outside of 100 feet or as set by law from voting locations located on County property during the period of time from 12 hours before early and/or election day voting begins and until 12 hours after the close of election day voting at that location.
