**Course Synopsis:** This class will teach visual communication and blend technical skills with creative development. **Art Fee:** The art fee for the year (two semesters) is \$30 dollars. The art fee will purchase your sketchbook and needed art supplies. If you have any specialty tools you would like to have in class, you may bring them to use.
