SCIENCE LESSON: CLASSIFICATION OF ORGANISMS 6.I2CD

THE LEARNER IS EXPECTED TO: recognize that the broadest taxonomic classification of living organisms is divided into currently recognized domains and identify the basic characteristics of organisms, including prokaryotic or eukaryotic, unicellular or multicellular, autotrophic or heterotrophic, and mode of reproduction, that further classify them in the currently recognized kingdoms.
