## Test Registration Information and Reminders

- The TSI (Texas Success Initiative) Assessment is computer adaptive, which means questions increase or decrease in difficulty, and the exam is untimed. The exam consists of multiple-choice Reading, Writing and Math. Students should take the TSI exam before course selection to ensure eligibility for the course.
- The State of Texas requires a [Pre-Assessment Activity \(PAA\)](#) to be completed prior to testing. Print and bring certificate of completion to the exam.
- At ACC, all placement tests are taken in the Testing Center located in Building A. ACC is located at 3110 Mustang Rd. Alvin, 77511. Cost is \$39.00 for the entire exam or \$15 per section if taken at ACC. **Students are encouraged to take all 3 sections of the exam but are only required to take the section needed for the course of interest.** A picture ID is required. **Meet with your ACC DC Advisor to review your scores and discuss course selection after you complete the test.**

- Students only retest in the area(s) they did not pass.
